SARFAESI Act, passed in the year 2002, is a law emerging and a weapon strengthening the hold of co-operative banks. The act applicable on both co-operative and commercial banks has been a relief to Indian lenders so as they can recover their dues quickly. The act has empowered the banks and financial institutions to recover the loans directly by auctioning the residential and commercial properties of the borrower, which had been a long drawn process earlier as the institutions were left with only recourse carrying a civil suit.
